- The Albanese Government is taking decisive measures to curb 'visa hopping' from 1st July 2024 in Australia's migration system for FY 2O24-25 where the Visitor Visa and 485 Temporary Graduate Visa holders will not be able to apply for Student Visas onshore. Read More!
- Starting July 1, 2024, Australia will update visa conditions 8107, 8607, and 8608 to improve labour market mobility for temporary migrants. Changes benefit visa holders under subclasses 457, 482, and 494, allowing them to work for new employers for up to 180 days at a time or 365 days total if they cease employment with their sponsor. - Engineers Australia will raise its fees starting from July 1st for the fiscal year 2024-2025. These fees are for their professional assessment service, which aids individuals in obtaining migration visas. They cover the expenses associated with conducting a thorough evaluation of qualifications. Read More!

- → British Columbia is set to launch three new Provincial Nominee Program (PNP) streams for international graduates in January 2025. These streams are tailored for recent graduates with Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctorate degrees from eligible Canadian institutions. Key eligibility criteria include a minimum Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) 8 proficiency. Read more!
- Immigration Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) has halted the practice of flagpoling for international students applying for Post-Graduation Work Permits (PGWP) at Canadian ports of entry, effective June 21, 2024. This decision aims to streamline border operations and maintain immigration system integrity, according to Immigration Minister Marc Miller. Read more!

Key Analysis: The table provides a summary of recent Express Entry draw results in 2024, highlighting key details such as the draw date, type, number of ITAs (Invitations to Apply), and the minimum Comprehensive Ranking System (CRS) score required for each draw. This draws targeted candidates under the Provincial Nomination Program with a relatively high CRS score requirement of 663.
